The Committee is invited to:

- Review, assess and scrutinize the paper noting its intention for achieving the project outputs and outcomes;
- Consider and approve the MYCWP for the Regional IW R2R Project; and
- Consider and endorse a further no-cost extension of up to 12-months from October 1, 2021 subject to UNDP policies to deliver on the project outcomes.











Key considerations for the proposed Multi-Year Costed Workplan (MYCWP)

- Delay of 7-months (Mar-Oct 2020 & counting) Covid-19 pandemic
- Technical requirements based on the approved-modified Science to Policy theory of change
- Logframe and MYCWP, and absorptive capacity (current level of spending) of the national demonstration projects
- Commitment to deliver the outputs in at least 6 participating countries supportive of mainstreaming R2R in planning and/or policy
- Trial and demonstrate the effectiveness of spatial prioritization land-sea model to 1-2 additional Pacific Island Countries
- Sufficient time to advocate for upscaling R2R (i.e. lessons learned documents, frameworks, guidelines, etc.):
 - Guidelines/framework for mainstreaming R2R in the Pacific
 - o Guidelines for characterizing and prioritizing coastal areas for ICM investments
 - o Ridge to Reef Capacity Building Framework in the Pacific













Management features of the MYCWP adapting to Covid-19 Pandemic

- (Intensified) non-conventional approach for providing advisory support (technical, management, administrative) to national implementation provision of written guidelines and conduct of virtual meetings
- Change in modality of contracting consultants i.e. engaging national consultants versus international consultants (about 30 national consultancy contracts anticipated once the second extension will be granted by UNDP)
- **Application of national procurement process** versus SPC procurement for regionally driven activities to facilitate decisions in contracting of works and services (e.g. studies and surveys)
- Direct access to funds allocated for regionally driven activities by national projects
- Granting additional request for no-cost extension to national demo projects to mitigate implementation delays (indications from FSM, Niue, Nauru, Tonga, PNG)
- Sufficient time to document & advocate lessons learned resulting from the testing of innovative approaches of at least 14 participating countries













Budgetary implications of the MYCWP adapting to Covid-19 Pandemic

- Availability of funds to finance the approved MYCWP of the national demonstrations
- Availability of funds to finance ongoing commitments such as JCU PGC/Diploma, regional consultancies, and Terminal evaluation
- Budget allocation for nationally procured consultants to carry out regional activities in anticipation of the approval of the second no-cost extension by UNDP
- Reallocation of travel budget in anticipation of the prolonged Covid-19 Pandemic (lasting until June 2021)
- Reserved travel budget for RSC, RSTC & JCU face to face meetings in 2021 in anticipation of the lifting of travel ban due to Covid-19 by June 2021














Fund allocation per component during the second no-cost extension




Comp 2 Strengthening capacities for R2R






Fund allocation per component during the second no-cost extension

- Total of 54 percent









No-cost extension process flow

Step 1: Agency Head transmits request for Extension to RPCU

- Project manager (PM) reviews the logframe (LF) to determine outputs not delivered
- Revise the MYCWP indicating schedule of delivery of outputs & allocate corresponding budget
- Draft request for extension & attach the updated LF & MYCWP

Step 2: RPCU reviews request

- Once found in order (Yes), prepare a Letter of Variation (LoV) indicating new project end date to be signed by DDG of SPC. Signed LoV will be sent to PM for countersignature by authorized signatory
- If found NOT in order, write email to PM & Head of Agency to inform of RPCU's action/reason.

Step 3: RPCU notifies PM & Head of Agency on the finding/s of SPC

- If Yes, PM facilitates countersigning of LoV by the authorized signatory.
 PM forward countersigned LoV to RPCU
- If Not in order, PM complies with the RPCU requirement/s & start again from Step 1.


