
Output Status Per Component









Key Issues

- A follow up project?
 - Continue testing, replicate and upscale?
 - > what to do with R2R tools & products being developed?
 - Examples: online regional dbase, spatial prioritisation modelling, science-policy framework,
- No-cost extension?
 - Streamlined strategy to deliver on full science-policy continuum
- Efficacy of R2R Programme Governance Platforms
 - ➢ RSC, RSTC, RPCG





Specific adaptive management actions during Covid-19 Pandemic

- (Intensified) non-conventional approach for providing advisory support (technical, management, administrative) to national implementation – provision of written guidelines and conduct of virtual meetings
- Change in modality of contracting consultants i.e. engaging national consultants versus international consultants
- Application of national procurement process versus SPC procurement for regionally driven activities to facilitate decisions in contracting of works and services (e.g. studies and surveys)
- Direct access to funds allocated for regionally driven activities by national projects

Community Communauté

- Reallocation of travel budget (except for RSC, RSTC & JCU face to face meetings)
- **Granting additional request for no-cost extension** to national projects to mitigate implementation delays (e.g. Cook Islands and Palau)

PacificR2R Samoa Rapid Coastal Assessment Team complete trial forest biodiversity and cover assessment of Fagalii Catchment with information on endemic and invasive species. Team incl Ministry of Natural Resources and #Environment, local experts and community voluteers. (December, 2018)

- Conducted Island Diagnostic Analysis (IDA) to the priority countries (coinciding with the RapCA).
- Enhanced procedures for characterizing island coastal areas for Integrated Coastal Management (ICM) in collaboration with national stakeholders.
- Successfully trialed the refined methodology for the procedure and required indicator sets driving the linked land-sea model.









Future Opportunities & Directions

- Technical & innovative technologies & related measures mainstreaming R2R concept across water, forest and coastal areas
- Resource governance dimensions mainstreaming R2R aligned with community to cabinet approach
- IDA/SoC/SAF/SAP process and formulations to access and leverage funding support (GEF-8, EU and others), building on previous consultations, frameworks and policies (e.g. SPREP SAP, 1997)




Budget share per component


